SCHOOL SUPPLY DRIVE: ENDS OCTOBER 6TH

We are collecting school supplies for Washington Middle School, which serves a high percentage of Kenosha's low-income families. When students don't have needed school supplies, teachers fill the gap with items from their classroom closet, usually purchased with their own money. Help us fill those closets with the following supplies and let students and teachers focus on education.


- 👉 Pencil pouch/box
- 👉 Glue sticks
- 👉 Colored pencils
- 👉 #2 pencils
- 👉 Pens (no gel pens) Blue, Black, and Red
- 👉 Post it notes
- 👉 Highlighters
- 👉 Washable markers
- 👉 Low odor dry erase markers
- 👉 Pocket folders
- 👉 Wide ruled single subject notebooks
- 👉 Wide ruled loose leaf (theme) paper
- 👉 Wired earbuds with microphone
- 👉 Backpacks (no drawstrings)

In addition, these items help keep the classroom clean and healthy, and address student needs:

- 👉 Facial tissues-large boxes preferred
- 👉 Hand sanitizer
- 👉 Sanitizing wipes (Clorox, Lysol)
- 👉 Packs of girls' underwear (ages 12-16, 4/XS-8/XL)
- 👉 Travel size deodorant, soap, toothpaste, mouthwash
- 👉 Fabric deodorizer spray
- 👉 Individually wrapped healthy snacks for hungry students
